Responsorial Psalm: *I thank you for the wonder of my being.*

Readings at Mass: *Isaiah 49:1-6, Acts 13: 22-26, Luke 1: 57-66,80*

“The Lord called me before I was born, from my mother’s womb he pronounced my name.”

John, like the Old Testament prophets before him, was called for a particular vocation in the service of God. He was to be that voice who called out in the wilderness, “prepare the way of the Lord.”and to announce “ behold the Lamb of God who take away the sins of the world.”

Pentecost and the establishing of the new covenant was the fulfilment of the word spoken by the prophet Joel where the Spirit would be poured out upon all flesh.

John Henry Newman spoke about this vocation beautifully; “God has created me to do him some definite service; He has committed some work to me which he has not committed to another. I have my mission; I never may know it in this life, but I shall be told it in the next. I have a part in a great work; I am a link in a chain, a bond of connection between persons. He has not created me for naught. I shall do good, I shall do His work; I shall be an angel of peace, a preacher of truth in my own place, while not intending it, if I do but keep His commandments and serve Him in my calling.”
