Dear friends,

We see Jesus sending out the twelve disciples with the message of the gospel of peace. His instructions are to take nothing with them, mirroring the exodus of the twelve tribes who left Egypt leaving much behind. The disciples are imaging the new Israel, where they are set free from slavery and establish a covenant with God and the promise of a land flowing with milk and honey.

In order to receive the gift we have to let go of what we are holding on to. It's the letting go and taking nothing with us as we follow Jesus that often leads many to reject the gospel and consequently those who bear the gospel of Jesus.
