Anyone who wants to save his life will lose it; but anyone who
loses his life for my sake, and for the sake of the Gospel, will save
it.”

Dear friends,

Today we're given quite a paradox in the Gospel, it is by losing
our lives that we save them; surely this can't be right. The
point here is that we are called to follow Christ, and just as he
was willing to die for us and then was resurrected to eternal
life; we too can be raised to that eternal life.

But this isn't just looking forward, our eternal life with Christ
begins now. It began with our baptism, when we symbolically
died to the world to be raised with Christ. It will reach its
highest fulfilment after our death, when I pray that we will all
enjoy eternity in the beatific vision.

Between these two events though, we have a mixed
existence; we have to make a constant choice to keep Christ
as the centre of our lives, and this often involves challenges –
taking up our cross to follow him. But he also gives us a
foretaste of what we can expect in heaven; in the Sacraments,
and especially in the Holy Eucharist, we have his presence
among us. And it is through the grace given in the Sacraments
that we have the strength to undertake that constant struggle
to taking up our crosses.
