Response to the psalm : The Lord is king, with majesty enrobed.

Dear Friends,

We celebrate the Feast of Title today at Christ the King and we should rightly make much of this celebration as it should give us a hint and reminder of the charism we are graced with and be reflective of our celebration of the mass.

For all of us though in both parishes we should also take great consolation in Jesus' affirmation in the gospel that he is indeed a king, but not of this earthly realm. This is important because as human history tells us political powers, nations, and kingdoms rise and fall, come and go. In this volatile world where all is subject to change and decay we are reminded that we, while in the world, are not of the world as we are citizens of the eternal kingdom of God through the grace of our baptism and ongoing conversion.

Jesus is our Alpha and Omega, our beginning and our end, the One from whom we came and the One to whom we return. Therefore, while life can indeed be turbulent in and outside of the church militant our ultimate destiny, by God's love and grace, is to be united with the saints and angels in the Church glorified.

Jesus has the words of eternal and speaks them bearing witness to the truth, and is indeed the manifestation of truth in the flesh revealing himself as Christ the King. In John's gospel Jesus says, "If you continue in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth and the truth will make you free."
