**"In reply Peter and the apostles said,'Obedience to God
comes before obedience to men."**

Dear Friends,
We encounter Peter boldly speaking these words to the
High Priest who had demanded that the apostles stop
speaking in Jesus' name.

Peter is a transformed man after his encounter and
restoration by the resurrected Jesus by the sea of Tiberias.

Peter was undoubtedly haunted by his 3 fold denial of
Jesus when Jesus was before the High Priest and council.
The understandable fear of what might happen to him and
the wrath of the people around him led Peter to give way to
self preservation.

In the world's eyes this sort of failure would be the very
reason that Peter would be barred from leadership and
responsibility. However, Jesus sees more than
appearances and into the heart. Jesus asks 3 times, "Do
you love me?" In so doing Jesus draws out the true longing
of Peter's heart and prepares him for his role as chief
pastor of God's people - against all conventional wisdom.

Peter, in Jesus, encounters a love that is stronger than
death. A love that has brought him to new life in the power
of the Holy Spirit - he will never be the same again. He is
strengthened in the knowledge that nothing in this world
can separate him from the love and life that is his in Christ
Jesus.
