Response to the Psalm : We are his people, the sheep
of his flock.

Dear Friends,

The fourth Sunday of Easter is also called Good Shepherd
Sunday. In each of the three lectionary cycles, the Gospel
is taken from the tenth chapter of the Gospel of John.

Today's Gospel speaks powerfully about the familiarity and
intimacy between Jesus and his disciples, expressed as
recognising and knowing another's voice. It also speaks to
the relationship between Jesus and the Father.

In the Gospel of John, Jesus identifies so closely with the
Father that he tells us that they are one—not just close, but
actually one thus alluding to the Blessed Trinity.

To know Jesus is to know the Father. Jesus doesn't just
bring us closer to the Father, Jesus puts us directly into
contact with God the Father, removing all distance between
us.

Our relationship with Jesus is an invitation to share in the
life of God. It is a relationship that if nurtured will bring
overwhelming joy and support to people of faith throughout
their life.
