The season of Easter concludes with today's celebration,
the feast of Pentecost.

Next Sunday we celebrate the feast of the Most Holy Trinity
and the following week, the Body and Blood of Christ.
All of these celebrations in the Church's year are poignant
reminders of Christ's divinity and of the special gifts that he
has endowed upon his Church and people by the events of
Easter. Gifts that should touch the very heart of us all.

But Eastertide does not end here because through Christ's
suffering, death and resurrection we have an ongoing

Easter people by our baptism.
