The Feast of Ss Peter and Paul

Readings at Mass : Acts 12:1-11; 2Tim 4:6-8,17-18; Mt 16:13-19

Response to the psalm : From all my terrors, the Lord set me free.

Dear friends,

There has been a tradition of arranging ordinations on the feast day of St Peter and St Paul, indeed Fr Thomas gives thanks for his 1st anniversary as a priest.

Peter and Paul are the two most prominent Apostles. Peter is the rock upon which Christ, in his own words, will build his Church. The Petrine office is first and foremost the defender of the one true faith. It is to hold that faith, the revelation of Jesus himself, whom Peter declared to be the Christ, the Son of God, from misunderstanding and corruption.

St Paul on the other hand is seen as the greatest herald of that faith in proclaiming the gospel of Christ in his missionary endeavours. Anyone called to ordained ministry is aware, or should be at least, of the particular apostolic responsibility placed on him to faithfully teach the faith and to proclaim the gospel afresh in each generation.

However, although there is a particular responsibility given to the ministerial priesthood and diaconate there is also a vocation for all the baptised to be ministers and heralds of the gospel. As in the words of St Paul, that which I have received, I pass onto you.

This is particularly urgent in our own generation as the pressures on the young are greater than they have ever been. We need both the confidence and intercession of St Peter and St Paul but also to trust that the gospel we have received is indeed the message of eternal life. Every blessing Fr Neil
