Readings at Mass : Deut 30:10-14; Col 1:15-20; Luke 10:25-37.

Response to the psalm :

Dear friends,
'Who is my neighbour?'

We are told that the lawyer asked this question because he was 'anxious to justify himself'. This seems an odd way to follow what has just happened, he answered a question correctly and Christ told him 'do this and life will be yours.' We would expect him to be happy – he has been given a strong affirmation. But it would seem that there was something going on deep inside him. We are not told that he was a bad person, he clearly knew the teachings of the Old Testament to be able to reply to Christ's question...but the thought of loving his neighbour caused him anxiety.

Maybe he realised quite how strong that commandment is. Maybe he realised that whilst he was good at loving his friends, those whom he was close to, he had some niggling feeling that he should be doing more. He was looking for Christ to justify him, but of course Christ wanted to call him to something higher – which is why he gave us that beautiful, but challenging story of what a neighbour is. When we get that niggling feeling - perhaps I should be doing more- let us accept God's Challenge .
