**Response to the psalm : On the day I called, you
answered me, O Lord.**

Dear friends,

In today's gospel reading from Luke, Jesus is asked by his apostles "Lord, teach us to pray".

It was not that the apostles didn't already know how to pray as they prayed in common, as all Jews did in the synagogue and at key times during the day.

However, living close to Jesus, they had discovered a new way to live in close fellowship which meant that they felt the need to address the Father in a different way.

Jesus waited for them to ask him to teach them how to pray.

The change that came about for the apostles was the realisation that prayer does not lie in the quantity of words and the mere repetition of formulas, but instead, in the inner attitude of faith and love of God.

This requires occasionally casting aside our prescribed books of prayer, and simply lifting our hearts and minds to God as Father and friend. A God who loves us and who is always waiting for us to share a silent moment with him.

Therefore, the real gift of prayer is not to talk too much, but to surrender our lives into God's loving hands.
