Dear friends,

Over the past few weeks, Jesus has been presenting two options to us – a world which passes, which fades, ultimately which dies; and a world which endures through eternity. We look at the world around us, and we cannot fail to notice that things don't last – some things can survive longer than others, but in the end everything will crumble into dust.

This can sound very depressing, but with Christ it is only the first step. Realising that everything around will pass, realising that we ourselves will pass away, is only the prelude. What Christ brings to us is assurance that there is something which will not – that God existed long before the universe, and that God will continue to exist long after it. And that we are invited to take part in this.

So when we look at our changing world, this should not make us sad – rather, it should cause us to look to the God who truly lasts, and who wants us to turn to him so that we can last with him to eternity.
