Dear friends,

Two weeks ago saw the Canonisation of John Henry Newman, the first English person who has lived since the 17th century to be officially recognised as a saint by the Catholic Church.

The process has taken over 60 years, for it was in 1958 when a file was first opened by the Church to consider his beatification. In 1991 he was proclaimed Venerable, in 2018 Beatified, now Canonised.

For Catholics this was a truly great moment and a well earned recognition for a man of immense faith, who has been an inspiration to many.

But we should not overlook that along with his canonisation were four women; Mother Mariam Theresia, an Indian mystic and stigmatist founder of the Congregation of the Holy Family, Marguerite Bays, a Swiss laywoman and stigmatist, Mother Giuseppina Vannini, a religious sister from Rome founder of the Daughters of St. Camillus and Sister Dulce Lopes, the first Brazilian born female saint who was nominated twice for the Nobel Peace Prize.

Through their lives these women proclaimed Christ in a unique way, and they achieved this not just by their actions but also by their prayer life, their humility, and by recognising the need for God's grace in their lives.

Today's readings remind us that, through prayer and humility before God, we too can come to recognise the presence of God, and it is that presence that leads us to achieve greatness in His eyes for *the Lord answers the cry of the poor*.
