On behalf of the beneficiaries (the student nurses) who need to be supported with fees in order to continue their training, I say a **'big thank you'** and our profound appreciation for this generous

injection into the bursary fund. 🙏 Any student that receives support from this bursary fund during their training will be bonded to work at the hospital for at least one year after qualifying. This of course guarantees them a job because they will be employed by the hospital and they will have at least one years experience under their belt. That will give them a great chance to have a noble career as nurses.

Rededication of England as the Dowry of Mary. England has been called the Dowry of Mary since 1381, showing the strong devotion of the English to the Mother of God. The rededication is taking place on March 29th, the Sunday after the Solemnity of the Annunciation. There will be 30 days of prayer to prepare us for this event, starting on Feb 29th.
